Prerogatives for parties and candidates

It is worth mentioning that Article 51.1.b.11 of the General Law on Political Parties states that in the year of the election in which only the federal Chamber of Deputies or the Congresses of the federal entities are renewed, each national or local political party, respectively, will be granted for campaign expenses an amount equivalent to thirty per cent of the public funding for the support of its permanent ordinary activities for that year.

And, that once the operation of numeral 1 of article 51 of the General Law of Political Parties has been carried out to determine the financing for obtaining votes in electoral campaigns, which results from multiplying the amounts approved for ordinary public financing by 0.30, resulting in the aforementioned amounts.

In view of the above, this Election Institute does not allocate public funding for each of the popularly elected positions.

- Limits on private funding for each of the positions

Pursuant to Agreement IMPEPAC/CEE055/2024 dated 26 January 2024, the State Council of the Morelos Institute of Electoral Processes and Citizen Participation approved the determination of the limits of private funding that political parties may receive from their activists and supporters, pre-candidates and candidates, as well as the individual limit of contributions from supporters during the 2024 fiscal year, which in its operative points, which are set out below, approves the following:

"FIRST: This State Electoral Council is competent to issue the present agreement in terms of the recitals of the same.

SECOND: The maximum amounts of private funding that political parties with accredited recognition before this electoral body will be entitled to receive from their militants, supporters and candidates for the 2024 fiscal year are approved, as well as the individual limit of contributions from supporters, in terms of what is indicated in the considerations of this agreement.

THIRD: The Executive Secretary is instructed to notify this agreement to the political parties accredited before the State Electoral Council of this electoral body.

FOURTH. It is proposed to the General Council the individual limit of contributions from sympathizers, in money or in kind, that each political party may receive in the year two thousand twenty-one, which amounts to the sum of \$425,997.40 (Four

hundred and twenty-five thousand nine hundred and ninetyseven pesos 40/100

FIFTH: The sum of private funding of political parties, in all its forms, including self-financing and financial returns, may in no case exceed the amount of public funding for the support of their permanent ordinary activities, campaign expenses and specific activities.

The aforementioned is in accordance with Article 56, paragraph 2, subparagraph b) of the LGPP, as well as Article 123, paragraph 1, subparagraph b) of the Audit Regulations, which establishes that, in the case of contributions from candidates and supporters during Federal Electoral Processes, it shall be ten percent of the expenditure ceiling for the immediately preceding presidential election.

Article 56, paragraph 2, section d) of the aforementioned Law, as well as Article 123, paragraph 1, section d) of the Audit Regulations, establish that contributions from sympathizers will have an individual limit of 0.5%, zero point five percent of the expenditure ceiling for the immediately preceding presidential election.

And that in relation to the provisions of article 56, paragraph 2, b) and d) of the LGPP, contributions from candidates and supporters can be made during electoral processes, taking into consideration 10% of the expenditure ceiling for the immediately preceding presidential election, as well as the annual individual limit of supporters of 0.5%, zero point five percent of the aforementioned ceiling.
