Prerogatives for parties and candidates

It is worth mentioning that Article 51.1(b)(II) of the General Law on Political Parties states that in the year of the election in which only the federal Chamber of Deputies or the Congresses of the federal entities are renewed, each national or local political party, respectively, will be granted for campaign expenses an amount equivalent to thirty per cent of the public funding for the support of its permanent ordinary activities that corresponds to it in that year.
