- Main attributions on the election framework:
- ✓ Approve the ballot's model, documentation, and electoral materials according with the guidelines issued by INE.
- ✓ Approve the necessary agreements, resolutions, and regulations to carry out the organizations, development, and calculation of the election.
- Carry out the election at state level, by Judicial Party or Judicial Parties, according with territorial field determined by the Administrative Body.
- ✓ To do the state calculation of the election.
- ✓ Issue the criteria for holding debate forums among candidates and establish the bases so the public, private or social sector institutions can provide such spaces free of charge, watching their proper development and the participations of the candidates who wish to do so under equity conditions.
- ✓ Ensure equity in the development of the campaigns among candidates.
- ✓ Issue the necessary agreements to assist in the equitable diffusion of the candidates' proposals and promote the citizen participation in the electoral process.
- ✓ Issue guidelines of general application to the Electoral Judicial Party's Councils and in case, of their Auxiliar Bodies.
- Dictate the necessary agreements to implement the attributions established on this paragraph and others established by the Code. For every Judicial Party, Electoral Judicial Party's Councils and in case, their Auxiliar Bodies must be designated to carry out the stages of the Electoral Journey, calculation, and results of the election of Magistrates and Judges, within their respective areas of jurisdiction, following the applicable norms and other regulations and guidelines issued. The Council may not suspend or interrupt the process or activities related to the organization, development, and calculation of the election of Magistrates and Judges.

(Article 412 of the Electoral Code of the State of Aguascalientes).

- ✓ Dictate the necessary steps for the prompt and expeditious handling of matters within the jurisdiction of the Court.
- ✓ Apply enforcement measures through the Court's Presidency.
- ✓ Substantiate and resolve the appeals referred to in the Article 355 of the Electoral Code of the State of Aguascalientes.
- ✓ Approve the report to be submitted to the branches of the government, on the Court' intervention in the development of the elections.
- ✓ Order the publication of the definitive resolutions in the Official State Newspaper.
- ✓ Establish, within the scope of its powers, mechanisms to prevent, address, punish, and, where appropriate, eradicate political violence against women based on gender.
- ✓ Any other determined by applicable laws and regulations.

State Superior Court of Justice	 Each Public State Branch may nominate up to two candidates per position on an equal basis At least 50% of the nominations will be female. If the total number of nominations in each list results in an odd number, the remaining position must be female. Regardless of the number of candidates on the lists, they must be composed on an equal basis. 	
Judicial Disciplinary Court	The affirmative actions implemented by this authority for the positions up to elections were recorded in the General Council of the State Electoral Institute of Aguascalientes, which approves the rules to guarantee gender equity in the candidates list for the 2025 Extraordinary Electoral Process of the Judicial branch of the State of Aguascalientes identified with the alphanumeric code CG-A-06/25, which can be consulted along with its annex in the following links:

• Disclosure by the electoral authority

- 1. The State Electoral Institute of Aguascalientes makes available to citizens and candidates the "Info-Election" software tool, which contains the lists of candidates participating in the election for Magistrates and first instance judges, as well as other information related to the electoral process.
- 2. Similarly, the "Meet them" microsite has been habilitated, which contains information on the candidates' professional careers, proposals and contact methods, as well as a videoclip in which the candidates introduce themselves to the public and invite them to view their profile information. On the other hand, the General Council of the State Electoral Institute of Aguascalientes, through the Informative Forums Commission, approved by agreement identified with the alphanumeric code CG-A-44/25, the organization of seven judicial forums, spaces where the candidates to occupy the Supreme Court of Justice and civil, familiar and mixed matter courts, will be able to present themselves to the citizens, make known their profile and the proposals they intend to implement if elected. - Traditional mass media and interviews: In accordance with the Article 417 of the Electoral Code of the State of Aguascalientes, the contracting, by itself or through a third party of radio and television time for the purpose of promoting candidates, as well as advertising personal promotion in print or digital media, is prohibited.
- Social networks and use of written propaganda: In accordance with the Article 416
 of the Electoral Code of the State of Aguascalientes, the dissemination of candidacies
 for positions of Magistrates and Judges will only be permitted using social media
 networks or digital media for their promotion, if said candidacies do not make
 expenditures to enhance or amplify their content.
