For every Judicial Party, Electoral Judicial Party's Councils and in case, their Auxiliar Bodies must be designated to carry out the stages of the Electoral Journey, calculation, and results of the election of Magistrates and Judges, within their respective areas of jurisdiction, following the applicable norms and other regulations and guidelines issued.     - ✓ Order the publication of the definitive resolutions in the Official State Newspaper.
    - ✓ Establish, within the scope of its powers, mechanisms to prevent, address, punish, and, where appropriate, eradicate political violence against women based on gender.
    - ✓ Any other determined by applicable laws and regulations.
