- Conduct the full calculation of elections and issue the declarations of validity and the granting of majority certificates.
- ✓ Conduct the full calculation of the Judiciary of Mexico City, as well as grant respective certificates.

The number of candidacies eligible for each position is: Judicial Disciplinary Court: 3 Magistrates: 2 Judges: 2
