Characteristics of state electoral bodies

• Main attributions on the election framework:

- ✓ The State Institute is the authority responsible for the organization, development, and counting of votes for the election of judges of the State Judicial Branch. In the fulfillment of its powers, it shall ensure compliance with the principles of certainty, legality, independence, impartiality, integrity, maximum publicity, and objectivity, as well as gender parity.
- ✓ Apply the general provisions, rules, guidelines, criteria, and formats conferred upon it by the Political Constitution of the United Mexican States and the General Law of Electoral Institutions and Procedures.
- ✓ Develop and implement civic education programs.
- ✓ Guide the citizens of the state in the exercise of their rights and fulfillment of their political and electoral obligations.
- ✓ Carry out activities in preparation for election day in the state.
- ✓ Carry out the examination and total count of the elections held in the entity, based on the results recorded in the municipal count records.
- ✓ Issue majority certificates and declare the validity of the election to the candidates that obtained the most votes.
- ✓ Verify compliance with the general criteria issued by the National Electoral Institute regarding surveys or opinion polls on electoral preferences, which must be adopted by individuals or legal entities intending to conduct these types of studies in the state.
- ✓ Develop activities to guarantee the right of citizens to conduct electoral observation work in the state, in accordance with the guidelines and criteria issued by the National Electoral Institute.

¹ Currently, there are six out of seven council seats; one vacant position remains due to the appointment of a Council member to the position of Magistrate on the Quintana Roo Electoral Tribunal.



- ✓ Organize, develop, and conduct the vote count and declare the results of the citizen participation mechanisms provided for in the Citizen Participation Law of the State of Quintana Roo.
- ✓ Supervise the activities carried out by the district, local, and municipal bodies in the state during the electoral process.
- ✓ Act as electoral official regarding acts or events of an exclusively electoral nature.
- ✓ Inform the Technical Unit for Liaison with Local Public Bodies of the National Electoral Institute about the exercise of the functions delegated to it in accordance with the provisions of the General Law on Electoral Institutions and Procedures and the provisions issued by the General Council of the National Electoral Institute.
- ✓ Any other functions determined by the General Law on Electoral Institutions and Procedures and those not reserved to the National Electoral Institute in accordance with the regulatory framework.

- ✓ Substantiate and definitively resolve at the local level any means of challenging its jurisdiction under the Media Law.
- ✓ Resolve the special sanctioning procedure under the terms of this law.
- ✓ Substantiate and definitively resolve any challenges in citizen participation.
- ✓ Issue the internal regulations in accordance with the provisions established by this law.
- ✓ Conduct training, research, and dissemination work on electoral law.
- ✓ Enter into collaboration agreements with other courts, institutions, and authorities at all three levels of government for their improved performance.
- ✓ Notify the State Congress and the respective municipalities of the filing of appeals, as well as the final resolutions issued to those filed against election results.
- ✓ Any other functions assigned by the State Constitution, this Law, and the Media Law.

In which it was determined that only 9 positions are subject to election.



The bodies responsible for nominating candidates and the selection procedures were the responsibility of the three branches of the State of Quintana Roo: The Executive, Legislative, and Judicial branches through Evaluation Committees, which issued calls for applications that were published in the Official Newspaper of the State of Quintana Roo, on their official websites, and on social media.
